2. Among Tecumseh and Parra, one of them lived in Colorado, the other one worshipped the Eagle.

3. Three of the tribes are: the Sioux, the tribe which lived in Colorado, and the tribe which worshipped the Snake.

4. Sioux didn't live in Alabama. They also didn't worship the Eagle nor the Bear.

- 5. Apaches worshipped the Snake, or they lived in Alabama.
- 6. The Comanche leader was Tecumseh, or they lived in Colorado.
- 7. Horse was worshipped in Wyoming or by Creeks.
